## Kan Yasuda's Solo Exhibition "Touching the City"

An outdoor exhibition by Hokkaido-born sculptor Kan Yasuda has been held in Sapporo since 3 September. In Sapporo nine of Yasuda's sculptures are already on display permanently at public places such as JR Sapporo Station and Hokkaido Governor's Official Residence, and additional 20 pieces are specially place on public display so citizens can see and touch the art works in the city centre.

Kan Yasuda is an internationally renowned sculptor, who works particularly at marble and bronze sculptures at his studio at Pietrasanta in northern Italy. His sculptures can be seen also in The Arte Piazza Bibai, a sculpture park in central Hokkaido.
